## About the Job

TUCF personnel are required to provide training and procedural development of submarine escape and special submarine diving operations, including the provision of Pressurised Submarine Escape Training (PSET). Training is provided at the SETF using breath-held diving techniques. It includes curriculum instruction and development.

The main focus of Pressurised Submarine Escape Training (PSET) is the training of Submariners in the theoretical knowledge, practical skills and confidence needed to enable them to escape safely from a disabled Submarine.

TUCF personnel will be given specialised training conducted by the RAN in order to gain the qualifications needed to provide PSET Services.

In addition select personnel will also be required to assist TUCF management with;

- The co-ordination of training
- Supervision of training
- Systems co-ordination
- Diving and escape equipment co-ordination



One team leader position is available to suitably qualified experienced personnel.



**Tasks and Responsibilities**

All TUCF personnel will undertake instructional duties commensurate with their PSET and commercial diver qualifications and experience.

TUCF PSET Instructors may perform some or all of the following PSET instructor duties:

- Basic Water Worker
- Positional Water Worker
- Section Instructor
- Tank Top Coordinator

**Essential Skills and Qualifications**

The following essential skills and qualifications are required;

- Medically fit to dive in accordance with AS/NZS2299.1
- Hold a current senior first aid certificate
- Hold a current advance resuscitation certificate
- Hold as a minimum an ADAS Part 1 diver qualification or greater
- Hold an ADAS chamber operator certificate
- Have the ability to breath-hold dive to 20 metres

Where the above qualifications are missing or out of date, applicants are required to demonstrate their ability to meet the competencies inherent in the qualification. Once demonstrated, appropriate top-up training or refresher training will be provided by TUCF.

**Desired Skills and Qualification**

The following desired skills and qualifications will be considered;

- Hold an ADAS Part 1 supervisor qualification or greater
- Hold a Certificate IV in occupational training

Again where applicants can demonstrate the ability to complete the competencies listed in the qualifications above appropriate training will be provided by TUCF.

Work is expected to commence on 03 August 2009.
